ENCO Announces Integral SoundExchange Support

Southfield, Michigan, March 16, 2007: ENCO Systems Inc., a leading worldwide provider of Digital Audio Delivery Systems, announced the integration of reporting for SoundExchange into their 5.1e and later versions of DAD. SoundExchange is the entity designated to collect and distribute royalties for performance of copyrighted materials from certain US based broadcasters.

While traditional radio broadcasters were exempted from coverage for their over the air signals by the Digital Performance Right in Sound Recordings Act of 1995 (DPRA) and the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998 (DMCA), noninteractive "webcasters" (including original programmers and retransmissions of FCC-licensed radio stations by aggregators) are obligated to pay royalties and file reports to SoundExchange for these performance rights. This obligation also extends to broadcasters who are retransmitting their signal via satellite.

Don Backus, ENCO's Vice President of Sales and Marketing commented, "the requirement for reporting could have been a very onerous one for our clients who distribute content via the web and satellite, and by building support for the SoundExchange report format directly into DAD, we've tried to make that part of the task as painless as possible."

Support for the SoundExchange reporting is a no charge feature integrated into DAD version 5.1e and higher and is available to any DAD user currently under a technical support agreement.
